Fourth Sunday of the Year

Michael has no notion about holiness and certainly he has no ambition to be canonised. He will settle for a safe pass in the examination to get him into heaven. He sees the commandments as the test and so he hopes to get through by avoiding murder, stealing, adultery and by attending Sunday Mass as well as saying a few prayers each day. The commandments are the basic code by which he lives and judges himself. He will probably view today's Gospel as being the honour s course and of no great interest to him. That's a big mistake because the guarantee of God's presence in the next life is rooted in recognising his presence around us now.

The Sermon on the Mount which is introduced in today's Gospel is the core of Christ's teaching for his followers. Avoiding evil is only the first step in being a disciple of Christ. The next and crucial step is in doing good to others in every possible way, above and beyond the call of duty. It's to be so generous oneself that being untrammelled by this worlds goods, God can give one the kingdom of his friendship. It's to be so merciful to others that there is no hardness of heart, blocking one from receiving forgiveness for oneself. It's to believe that the strength of gentleness rather than the arrogance of power is God's way of building his kingdom. It's to be blessed by God. With God, there are no pass students, all are honours candidates and each one of us is called to greatness and we are all precious in God's eyes.

On a different note, this coming week has been designated as "Catholic Schools Week 2017". Catholic Schools Week gives us an opportunity to acknowledge and celebrate the tremendous contribution that our Catholic primary and post primary schools make not just to our society, but to the mission of the Church. Within our own parish, we are indebted to the many people who contribute enormously to the values of Catholic education and we pray special tribute to the principals, their teaching colleagues and ancillary staff of all our Catholic Schools for their personal fidelity and commitment. This year, the theme for the week is: "**Catholic Schools: Learning with Pope Francis to care for our common home**".

In keeping with the intentions of this week, we congratulate the boards of governors, teachers, parents and all associated with the great work they do as members of the Catholic School system. We wish God's blessing on their endeavours and we thank them sincerely for all they do in imparting to our children the values of the Gospel and preparing them for tomorrow's world.

First Saturday's Devotion When Our Lady appeared to Lucia at Pentevedra, she made a request for the Five 1st Saturdays & gave her great promise to assist at the hour of the death all those who on the 1st Saturday of five successive months go to Confession, receive Holy Communion, say 5 decades of the Rosary & keep her company meditating on the 15 Mysteries of the Rosary. In celebration of the 100 years since the appearance of Our Lady in Fatima, on the first Saturday of each month, Confessions will be celebrated in St Patrick's Cathedral at 9.30am, followed by Mass at 10am & recitation of the Rosary immediately after in Our Lady's Chapel. Confirmation Pledge At the Ceremony of Light on **Thurs 2nd March**, all P7 Pupils will have an opportunity to take the Confirmation Pledge & make the commitment to abstain from alcoholic drink & drugs until they are at least 18 years old. The issue of alcohol & drugs has become a big issue in society & the decision whether to take alcohol and/or drugs during ones teenage years will have a major influence on the rest of ones life. Alcohol/drugs could be the obstacle to someone achieving their hopes and dreams. In the coming weeks, members of the local PTAA Group will be visiting the Primary Schools in our Parish to encourage young people to seriously consider making this commitment & taking the pledge. Parents are encouraged to discuss this with their children. In becoming a Youth Pioneer, the person is joining a family of like minded young people who have made the decision to say no to alcohol/drugs until they are 18.

A Reflection on our Parish Baptism Programme The preparation course provides a chance for parents and God-parents to take "time out" of their often hectic and sleep deprived lives, to reflect on the true meaning of Baptism and its importance for the child, the family and the wider community. Two of the Biblical quotes used in the preparation course which I find particularly moving are "*I have carved your name in the palm of my hand*" and "*You are not alone, do not be afraid*". These quotations remind us that each one of us is known to and loved by God as unique and precious individuals.
