Dear Friends,

This Sunday's Gospel - The Wedding Feast at Cana is a popular Gospel proclaimed regularly at wedding ceremonies and it acts as a reminder to us that Jesus will always attend where He is invited. The first public miracle that Jesus performed was at the wedding feast, highlighting the importance of family life in His ministry. In our families and our homes this weekend, we have an opportunity to renew our invitation to Jesus to be present with us, to join in our everyday routine - maybe a simple prayer at teatime or maybe we could refill the holy water font.

Mary's role in the Gospel is important as her words to the workers present "do whatever he tells you" reminds us that the commandments that Jesus stated as the most important - the commandments of love - love of God and love of neighbour. Jesus' message is always a message of love and we are called to be instruments of that love - witnesses to his presence in our lives and our families.

This year as we focus on hope and the hope that comes from our relationship with Jesus - maybe we can consider ways to identify how our faith brings us hope and then identify ways of gently letting others know - our world needs hope now more than ever and we can be heralds of that hope. Our hope is always in Jesus' present in our midst - we don't need another saviour as we already have Jesus, however many people are so engulfed in worldly ways that they fail to see Jesus - who is always with us in our joys and our sorrows.


